Coloring Contest Guidelines

The True Meaning of Christmas

1. Contest is open to students in first through fifth grades.
2. Each student may enter one drawing on white 8.5 x 11 paper.
3. Entries must be postmarked no later than December 8, 2017.
4. Each student's name, school, grade and teacher must be written on the back of the drawing.
5. Drawings must be the original work of the students and may not have been published prior to the contest.
6. Drawings will be evaluated on creativity of illustrating the theme "The True Meaning of Christmas".
7. Drawings will not be returned.
8. Parents should complete and return the release form giving CUP permission to publish their child's drawing, in whole or in part.
9. There will be one overall contest winner and one winner in each grade level. The overall winner will receive four tickets to the Festival of Lights at the Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Gardens and ten Christmas cards featuring their drawing. The winners in each grade level will receive ten Christmas cards featuring their drawing.
10. Selected drawings may be displayed on the CUP website if the permission slip is returned.
11. Winners will be notified by December 18, 2017.
